Example Dictionaries

```
my_dictionary = {  
    "one": 1,  
    "two": 2,  
    "three": 3  
}  
  
Basic dictionary.
```

```
integer_keys = {  
    1: "one",  
    2: "two",  
    3: "three"  
}  
  
Integer keys.
```

```
mixed_keys = {  
    "one": 1,  
    2: 2,  
    3.0: 3,  
    (4, 1): 4  
}  
  
Mixed keys.
```

Basic Operations

dict[key]	Access dictionary value.
dict.get(key, value)	Access value/add new item if key does not exist.
dict[key] = value	Add new item/update a value if key exists.
del dict[key]	Delete item.

Dictionary Methods

dict.copy()	Copy dictionary.
len(dict)	Print dictionary length.
dict.items()	List dictionary items.
dict.setdefault(key,value)	Access value/add new item if key does not exist.
dict.fromkeys(dict, value)	Create new dictionary from dictionary keys with default value.
dict.keys()	List dictionary keys.
dict.values()	List dictionary values.
